

Work Site, Sidewalk Club & Basketball Camp Leaders

Flower City Work Camp is a ministry of Rochester-area churches working together to serve God and our community in practical ways. Each year during Spring Break, over 500 students and over 300 adults from more than 40 area churches serve homes, Sidewalk Clubs and Basketball Camp to bring the Gospel of Jesus Christ to some of the neediest areas in our City. The work includes home repairs; neighborhood Bible clubs; Basketball Camp; and prayer walks.



Work Camp would not function without the servant hearts of the adult volunteers from Work Camp's participating churches. Your church must send at least one Work Site, Sidewalk Club or Basketball Camp Leader for each four students that it expects to participate in Work Camp. Interested? Here's what to expect:



WORK SITE LEADERS – Lead teams of 8-10 Jr. and Sr. High students in home repair projects at sites throughout the City. A Site Leader must spend time prior to Camp visiting the site, identifying the work to be done, submitting a list of needed materials to complete the work, planning the work, and contacting the students prior to Work Camp. Then the Site Leader

guides the students in the work during the three working days of Work Camp (Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday).

SIDEWALK CLUB LEADERS – Lead teams of 8-10 Sr. High students in a backyard Bible club type program in City neighborhoods. Sidewalk Club Leaders must also help in pre-Camp preparations and attend some pre-Camp training sessions.



BASKETBALL CAMP LEADERS – Lead a team of Sr. High students in running a skills and discipleship basketball program in the City. Some pre-Camp training and preparation will be required.

Applications are available from your Youth Leader or Work Camp Representative and must be submitted no later than December 31.
