ADULT VOLUNTEER INFORMATION – WEST CAMP

Flower City Work Camp operates on the strength and commitment of the churches and volunteers who give of their time and energy to serve our City and enable teens to also serve God in practical ways. There are many opportunities for adults to participate in Work Camp, whether you have a few hours to give or an entire week.

If you are interested in serving at Work Camp you should:

1. Believe in Jesus Christ as your personal Savior.
2. Be past high school age.
3. Be an active attender at a participating church.
4. Fill out and submit an application.

GOFERS (TRANSPORTATION OF MATERIALS AND PEOPLE)

Gofers play an important role at Flower City Work Camp. They support Work Site teams by responding to requests for materials or other supplies. Gofer activities include purchasing and delivering materials, moving tools or supplies between sites and transporting students as necessary.

To serve as a Gofer at Flower City Work Camp 2011, make note of the following information:

1. Each gofer team must have a vehicle. (If you do not have a vehicle, you will be teamed with someone who does.) Trucks or vans are greatly appreciated.
2. Gofers under 21 are not allowed to transport people, only materials.
3. Gofers must attend the orientation meeting on the first night of Camp at Home Base. Teams and Work Sites will be assigned at this meeting, and supplies will be distributed.
4. Gofers must be available to work from 7:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. during the three working days of Camp. Gofers are encouraged to attend morning devotional times at Home Base and are welcome to stay for dinner in the evening and attend evening sessions as well.

FIRST AID

Flower City Work Camp 24-hour on-site first aid care by nurses or EMTs in the event of injury or illness. First aid care is needed to check on any injuries that may have occurred during the day, to monitor illnesses, and to supervise medication. It is not necessary to commit to all three days of Work Camp, nursing duties are spread among several individuals as schedules permit. Indicate your availability on the application form.

OVERNIGHT LEADERS

A major part of what God does in the lives of the students (and adults) at Flower City Work Camp happens during the evening teaching and worship times. Adult supervision is required not only to help with the aspects of "crowd control" but to be present as a support to the youth of your church as God works in their lives. Overnight Leaders should plan to be at Home Base by 6:30 p.m. on the evenings they are staying for a leaders' meeting prior to the evening programs. A male leader is required to be present each evening for the boys and a female leader for the girls attending Camp from your church. Overnight Leaders also supervise the rooms to make sure that the students obey Camp rules and get the sleep they need to do the next day's work.

To serve as an Overnight Leader at Flower City Work Camp 2011, volunteers must meet the following requirements:

1. Participate in the Overnight Leaders' meeting (6:30 p.m.) every evening before they stay over.
2. Check in at the registration table nightly.
3. Be aware of, support and enforce the rules of Flower City Work Camp.

KITCHEN CREW

Feeding the hundreds of student and adult volunteers is a key component of Work Camp so that the workers are well fed and energized for days of service. There are two areas of opportunity for food preparation at Work Camp:

1. You may serve by helping to prepare and serve the breakfasts and/or dinners provided at Home Base.
2. You may help with the Snack Bar in the evenings.

The application form indicates the hours of service for this Kitchen Crew opportunity.

GO2GUYS/SECURITY

Go2Guys/Security are the adult volunteers who provide security and information at Home Base each morning and evening of Work Camp. They help ensure that Flower City Work Camp is a positive, nurturing, and safe place in which our students serve.

Go2Guys'/Security's primary responsibilities include:

- **Answering Questions.** "When does the evening session start?" "Which room is my church sleeping in?" "Where is the lost and found?"
- **Enforcing the Rules.** All students are required to read, understand and go over the rules with their parents before committing to participate in Work Camp. Go2Guys/Security are there to ensure that the students remember that guys aren't supposed to be in the girls' rooms (and vice versa), we aren't supposed to have food in our rooms, we have not brought our cell phones and ipods to Work Camp, etc.
- **Keeping Track of Visitors.** A limited number of visitors are allowed to attend the evening worship session, but those visitors are not allowed to roam freely about Home Base. Go2Guys/Security are on hand to ensure that only participating Work Campers (identified by their bright wristbands) are in Work Camp areas.

Go2Guys/Security volunteer for shifts (see the application form). Therefore, you can volunteer every day, or as you're available.

SHOWER SHUTTLES (WEST CAMP ONLY)

Campers at West Camp (based at Hope Lutheran Church, 1301 Vintage Lane) shower off-site at Greece Arcadia High School/Middle School. Shower Shuttles are needed to transport students from Home Base to Arcadia and back again. Shuttles are in operation from 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday of Camp. This is a great service opportunity for anyone with a few hours to spare and a vehicle with room for several students. You'll be blessed to hear the students share stories of what they've seen and accomplished during the workday.

PRAYER WALK LEADERS

Each work site goes on a daily Prayer Walk in the neighborhood in which they are serving. While Student Shepherds and Site Leaders generally coordinate the Prayer Walks, on occasion of prayer warrior volunteers are needed to lead a team of students and adults in praying for the area around their work site. Prayer Walk Leaders make it possible for the students to be bold in prayer as they take a walk around the neighborhood, praying for the people and needs they encounter. Scheduling is very flexible, and your availability can be indicated on the application form.
