What is Flower City Work Camp?

Flower City Work Camp is a ministry of students from Rochester-area churches working together to serve God and our community in practical ways. Last year, almost 800 students from more than 45 area churches served at homes, Sidewalk Clubs and Basketball and Soccer Camps to bring the Gospel of Jesus Christ to some of the neediest areas in our City. The work includes home repairs, including painting, flooring, simple construction, cleaning, yard work, ceilings, plumbing, windows and doors; Sidewalk Clubs at which children play games, sing songs, make crafts, eat snacks and, most importantly, hear the life-changing Gospel of Jesus Christ; Basketball and Soccer Camp, at which children learn sports skills, Bible verses and how much God loves them; and prayer walks, during which Campers reach out in prayer and bring the needs of our City before God.



Why Should I Apply to Participate in Flower City Work Camp?

Flower City Work Camp might turn out to be the best week of the year, and you don't want to miss out! You will meet new people, make new friends, learn new skills, participate in great worship, be challenged from the Word of God and grow in your relationship with Jesus Christ, all while making a visible, important difference in the lives of people in the City of Rochester.



Are there different ways to be a part of Flower City Work Camp?

Yes! Students in Grades 7 through 12 may participate on Work Sites. Students in Grades 9 through 12 may apply to be a part of a Sidewalk Club Team, and Students in Grades 10 through 12 may apply to be a part of Basketball Camp. For Soccer Camp, only students in 11th and 12th grades may apply.



What Do I have to do to be a part of Flower City Work Camp?

Students in Grades 7 through 12 are welcome to apply through their church to participate in Work Camp. You must do the following:

- Complete a student application
- Commit to participate in all of Work Camp (from Monday registration through Friday's closing program)
- Commit to the various maturities required of student participants
- Pay the fee for the week
